Membership Grades and Application Process

1. Introduction

The Institute has seven grades of membership which are open to those individuals engaged in the professions relating to the removal and/or management of asbestos. The main professions that the Institute recognises and supports are those of asbestos removal manager, asbestos project manager, asbestos removal supervisor, asbestos analyst, asbestos surveyor and asbestos consultants.

The stringent entrance requirements and conditions of membership apply in order to satisfy the Institute's Council of Management, that standards are meticulously maintained. Adherence to a set of Rules of Membership forms part of the membership criteria

2. Membership Grades

All applications for membership (with the exception of affiliate) shall be from individuals engaged in a profession relating to the removal and / or management of asbestos who comply with the rules of membership.

Once submitted, applications shall be assessed, and the applicant informed of the grade of membership for which they are eligible. The Council may, having received the application and within their powers, as set down in the Rules, recommend that a variation to the grade of application be made.

Honorary Fellow

Shall be invited to transfer to the grade of Honorary Fellow by the Council of Management in accordance with the AMI Rules of Membership

Membership Grades and Application Process

The following grades of membership shall be admitted following the submission of an application which, in the opinion of the Council of Management, meets the requirements of the Rules of Membership for this grade of membership.

Full Member

Example Individual

Experienced Asbestos Removal Contract Manager, Asbestos Management Consultant, Asbestos Removal Project Manager, Senior Asbestos Consultant.

Professional Interview fee £180 Annual subscription £140

Competent Person Qualification

Example Individual

Individual who has completed the RSPH Level 4 Certificate in Asbestos Laboratory and Project Management, BOHS CCP (Asbestos) or BOHS Certificate of Competence in Asbestos.

Associate

Example Individual

Individual employed in a satellite discipline connected to the field of asbestos removal and/or management, overseas applicants.

Technician Grade Member

Example Individual

Asbestos Removal Supervisor, Asbestos Analyst or Asbestos Surveyor with at least 5 years' experience.

Example Individual

Applications accepted from those who meet the membership requirements.

3. The Application Process

A completed application form must be submitted online and a current CV uploaded, which details, where relevant, the requirements to satisfy the Rules of Membership for the grade of Membership being applied for.

- Relevant qualification certificates relevant to the application
- Any CSCS cards held relevant to the application
